Discipling, Evangelism, Raising up leaders, Church Planting, Missions. How does focusing on our churches being marked by loving God and loving others foster this germ?

- Breeds living what we are hearing/studying/seeing on display
- How does it live to help others? Live with them, Point to where you are looking, Learn of Jesus, Willing to be open – starting conversations, initiation, being
- If keep His goal then recognize only way to love Him/them is by looking to Him
- Living for God before others affects the norm
- Love tied to God -> Therefore, continue with God studying Him as He is
- Includes looking past/through other loves/germs
- Hold up character of God so love Him for who He is + how He told us to love Him
- Often follow for wrong reasons; soaking it up + applying it produces/reveals true love
- Intentional

- Should be normal to have love for God that love leads to certain goals (God determines i.e. These 5 things)
- That love should spread
- Define love —we need the puzzle cover— we have it; God is love
- If we love only for what He gives, we won't see Him for who He is
- Can only give what we have knowing about is different than knowing
- Sit first, then do Mary/Martha
- Structure gives foundation + boundaries for growing in love and following Jesus
- Psalm 90:12 each day lived with and under an eternal God
- Love comes in the following, yielding

What does it require to find what God values and does and then fill your life with more of these things?

- Being thankful
- In & under His Word
- Submission & humility
- Honoring His work in creation & sustaining
- Habits of Grace reading Word, meditating, prayer, fellowship of saints are not the end – we sink our roots into Him & spread branches out in service which drives us back to learn more of Him (need Him to serve Him)
- Matt. 6:33 what does seeking look like? Knowing only part of picture get wisdom & understanding (effort involved in bridge between facts & apprehension application)
- If "know more" than those around, then lose desire to learn more

What does it require to find what God values and does and then fill your life with more of these things? CONTINUED

- No growth if not identifying sin & enjoy the benefits of confession through Christ
- Discipleship process that includes all God intends to work in our lives
- Trust Christ to separate you from your sin (cleanse us from all unrighteousness)
- Rom 5:8 God demonstrates His love, while still sinners Christ died for us I John
 4:19 He Love because He first loved us
- Meditation Ps.1 day & night explaining to myself the truth I just read, I find must struggle more to understand

Why don't people listen to God's words/obey them (whether they profess to fear God or not)?

- Like children with parents: wisdom & experience outside doesn't matter because I haven't experienced it
- Limited sight/ don't love/ respect person enough to cross what they think appropriate
- Pride we know, so don't inspect our assumptions
- Lazy like our pleasures (easier to surf on web etc.)
- Perhaps see God/Kingdom/problem, take care how we listen
- We don't want His love, we've turned need for His love into serving our desire our hearts choosing to love God, yield to the Spirit
- John 3:36 NOT born again
- We put emphasis on God's work of sanctification what is <u>our</u> part

How do we worship with our lips but hearts are far from Him?

- 1. When fear of God stops with obedience without fellowship
- 2. Can't see God, so focus more on impressions of association with God and never actually getting to God
- 3. Working toward God without letting God lead
- 4. Not knowing Him

How does defining love for God + others tie to following Jesus?

- Way back to God
- Way forward after sin
- John 14:6 accountable
- Inside history, His character seen culminates in Jesus
- Seen Jesus, seen the Father This is My Beloved Son, listen to Him
- Ephesians 2:4 Made us alive together in Christ BUT God
- Love leads to seeing the problem of enmity, calling for reconciliation outside our power to achieve – God did it through Christ
- Those longing for redemption
- Persistence to know what it means to love God
- Those under God (humility) who respond to God
- Seeing beyond your need to glorious plan of God Transcendence

What does "being a disciple"/following imply or necessitate?

What does this say about our following Jesus if we are not actively helping others follow Jesus?

What does making disciples of Jesus include?

What would be some of the inhibitors to us cultivating this germ of following Jesus ourselves and helping others follow Jesus in the church?

How would following Jesus deal with these inhibitors?

What do we need to do to strengthen this germ/root of following Jesus in our lives individually and as a church?

Why will following Jesus individually/together naturally result in a culture of discipling, evangelism, raising up leaders, church planting, and missions? (What is the tie? How do they flow from each other?)

Underlying Assumptions/Goals in Adult SS for church as whole:

- 1. We must shift our focus from personal maturity and growth to building healthy churches.
- 2. We must focus on the roots, not merely the fruit.

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IF we do NOTHING else together, the Collective People of God must:

- I. Worship God Together. Romans 15:5-6
- II. Grow Individually and Corporately with a Growth that Comes from God. Eph. 4:15-16
- III. Protect/Defend the Name of God—His character and Eternal Purposes. II Tim. 1:13-14
- IV. Own the People in the Particular Expression of the Body of Christ where God has Placed you. 1 Cor. 12:18, Eph. 4:16
- V. Spread the Glory of God Hab. 2:14, I Pet. 2:9

We have looked at public worship services, relationships, growth, culture, now finally, What would need to be lifted up/allowed if want to build healthy churches with strong roots in faithful service?

Through the lens of these two goals, what were some of the changes hoped for by intentionally changing the goals during our *Future Grace* study leading to an 8 year study of that book? (longer studies over the years preceding)
