

Four reasons the conversation begins with difficulty:

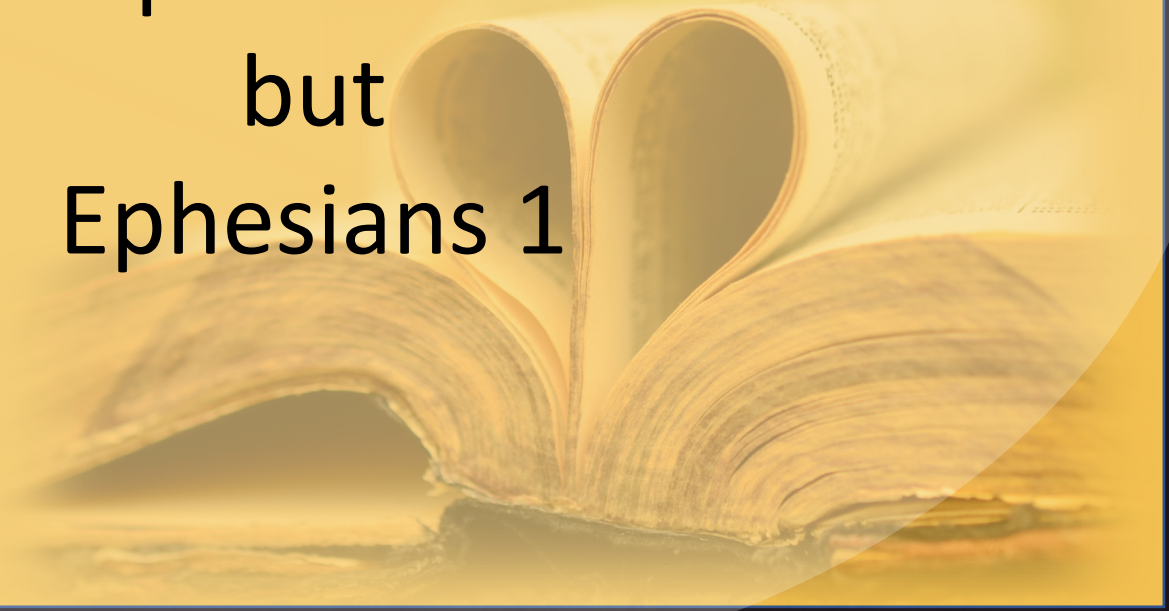
- unhelpful starting point

Ephesians 1



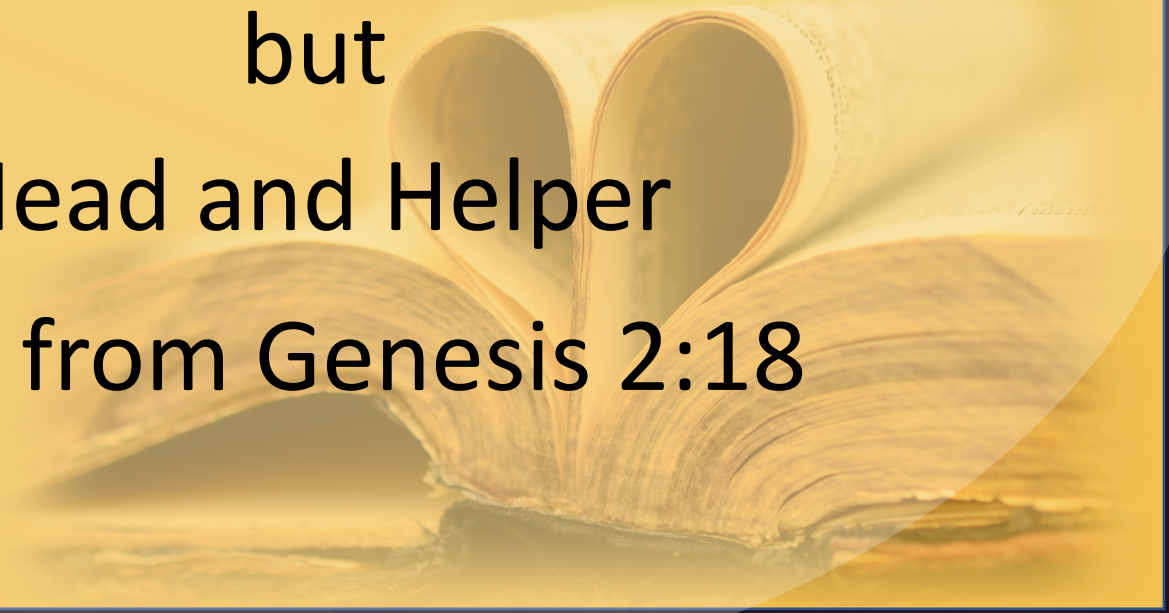
Titles and definitions

Submission is a choice

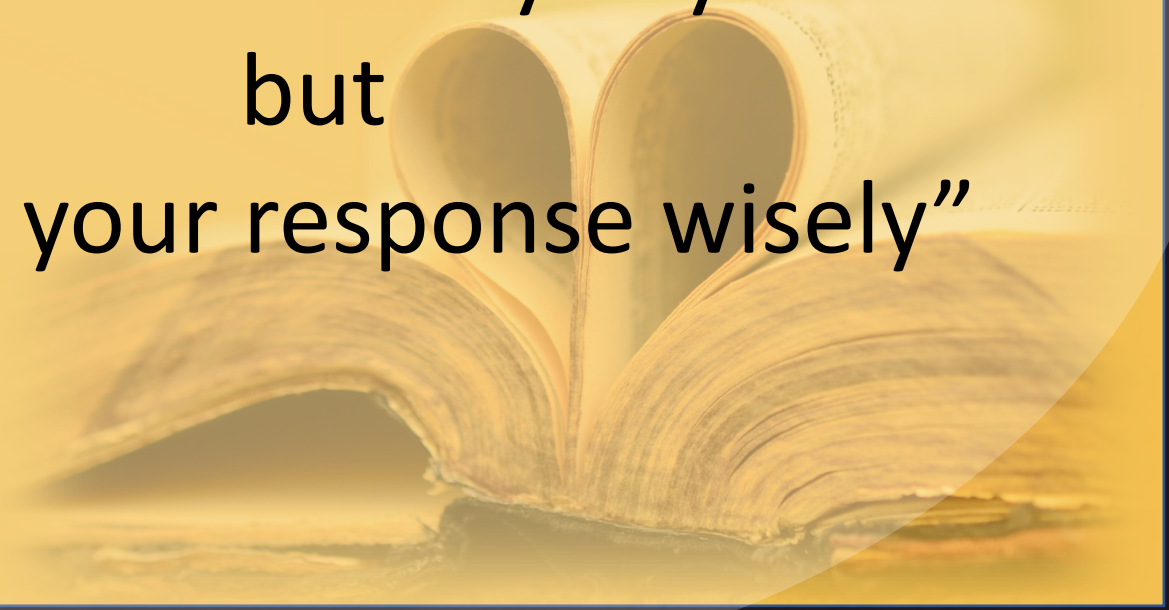


Counsel
