- We have selective faith – take parts we want ignore parts don't think we need
- Fear of people holding us to same standard
- Lazy - caught up in our own kingdom (schedule, family)
- We don't see Jesus or “all things – whatsoever He commanded” as worthy of sharing with others
- Perhaps shows we don't love people as we ought
- Shows we don't value growing “in all aspects to Him who is the head” – Eph. 4, Rom. 8:29

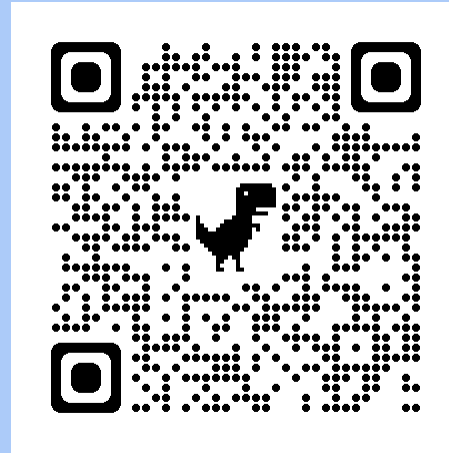

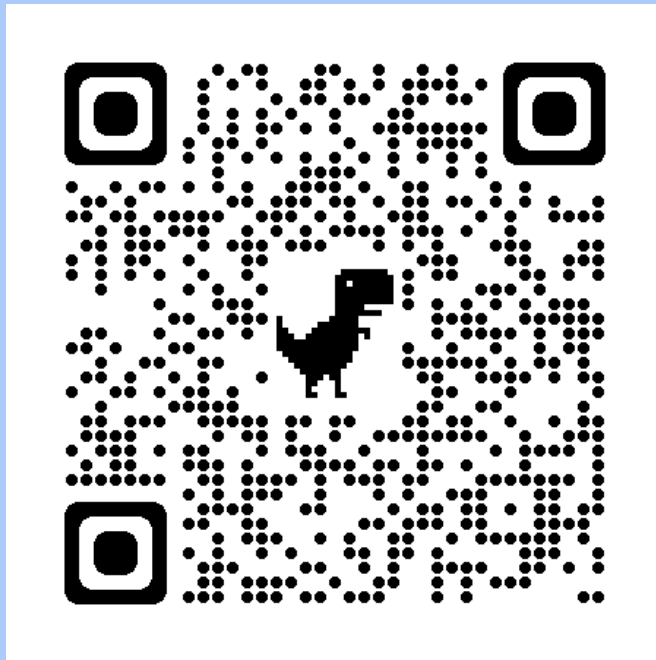
