What does making disciples of Jesus include?

- Making sure you yourself are a disciple
- Engage people intentionally
- Teach people what Jesus said
- Love souls
- Be careful of cloning ourselves a slow process, soil how are we cultivating soil that seed is growing in
- Ask, "Why do we want to make disciples?"
 - **1.** Commanded
 - 2. Why would we want to follow Jesus? (Establishing Value)
- Learning under God to follow Jesus then helping others to follow Jesus
- Share gospel with them

What does making disciples of Jesus include? - cont.

- Trust/allow Spirit to work w/ seed of gospel
- Asking what does God want them to hear/seeking
- Continued growth with it encouragement
- Trust God obedience
- Acknowledging to be a disciple
- Sense of need and desire for change
- Identify areas that need to be strengthened while we work & watch for work of God to take hold (firm foundation)

What does making disciples include? Colossians 1:28 - 2:7

- Struggle
- Evidence of dependence in struggle
- Motivating them to do work of building/encouraging
- Striving against what we used to protect/defend from being disciplined
- Point to Christ Himself, not just change behavior
- Protect from wrong doctrine
- Continuing to "own" responsibility for their continued stability and growth in the gospel
- Making your presence & intention felt
- Includes specific goal knit together in love

What does making disciples include? Ephesians 3:14, 16-17; 4:14-19

- Being stabilized in love
- First salvation, and then what does it look like for them to come to the completion of Christ
- In order to head this way, must understand love (we struggle, stroke one another, etc. - because so afraid we won't seem loving); therefore pray for growth in love of God
- Rejoicing/thankful in process with them (means noticing image of God, steps of growth)

What does making disciples include? Galatians 4:10-20

- It includes heartbreak
- At times being seen as an enemy
- Continuing after them pursuing , vying for affection
- Wrestling for the center of identity
- Proclaiming the gospel necessitates being immersed among them which means prioritizing issues underneath the gospel
- Slow, repetitive, consistent
- You living & showing needs allows platform for gospel focus
- Work of picking through experience, values, and process of adjusting focus from them to The Head (Eph.4:15-16) with patience & love
- Owns their "problems" even while sick & ministering elsewhere

What does making disciples include? Galatians 6:1-2

- Conscious "living by/with/under the spirit
- Restore with spirit of gentleness
 - What you see can also be seen in you
 - Standard that must be adhered to, and returned to
 - Personal responsibility for souls Ezek. 33, watchmen
- Not an option to walk by spirit
- If it is a burden, we bear it
- Three warnings against pride (5:26, 6:1, 6:3) tied together in the same battle against flesh for fellowship of the spirit
- Includes "seeing what is wrong" from a spiritual context then get involved
- Sin must be dealt with if healthy fellowship in church with head of the church (Christ)

What does making disciples include? Galatians 6:1-2 (Cont.)

- What if they don't want to work?
 - Love calls professing Christians to hold the line, to take their part (Heb. 40, I Cor. 12)
 - Gal. 6:9-10, God gets glory when we care for each, taking their part
 - Recognize they have not seen it

What does making disciples include? Hebrews 10:22-26

- Includes daily routine of examining soul for separation from God (i.e. Start with God)
- Completely trust the faithfulness of God to His promises
- Great danger is forgiven but continuing in willful sin if examine, more willful than we realize
- Tie between us wavering in unbelief & how we minister to other's souls
- We must include other's examining our actions/"motivations"
- V. 22 Drawing near ourselves is foundation for work in other's lives

What does making disciples include? 1 Peter 1:15-2:5

- Reminding that your redemption is secure because bought with Jesus' blood
- Someone drowning, inability to stop sinning, in God's eyes or "their" eyes

- We don't have to make up what God wants because we have His enduring word
- When we have different opinions & values of what is important & how to live
- v.22 calling to obedience to the truth
- Goal of purified souls that results in how you love others redeemed
- v.17 feel like an exile/outsider (Eph.2:19) on earth


