- Move away from youthful lusts (I want it now, I, Want, now, argue just to be right, unfiltered, looking to be noticed, act out when you don't get what you want, unnecessary risks)
- Pursue righteousness, love, peace, and faith
- Do this under God, in repentance and obedience, along side the Church body

- Wanting to appear knowledgeable- keep status
- Forget these things are a process that comes from an object of your faith
- Don't feel that the realness of Hell, forgiven sin does not bring gratitude

Can you think of ways our relationship with God is different than other relationships?

- Don't see the depth of what are relationship with God should be other relationships take
 our focus, time difference (I will have all eternity to work on this it can happen later)
- Don't recognize it as a relationship (no apparent give and take)
- His perfection separates us
- What is a relationship? Built on trust; have a goal; there can be different levels not all are good, and not all are close; Personal relations ships should involve getting to know another person more
- Should have an assurance of His love for us



Three Integral Components of the Church. Define Integral Components?

- Essential parts something needed to make it work
- Parts required to make a whole complete and work together
- Foundation solid base

- Being a "good" example
- Your purpose is to be viewed and examined by the world (living in a fishbowl) so that they can learn form us
- Stop being able to choose what everyone sees but people will see that we are sinners
- As a sinner on display we must continue to try and live as we should and follow/obey God better
- Toys on display are touched and interacted with as well pushed outside of your comfort zone
- People will view you differently as a Christian there will be expectations

- Fear of other people's treatment and judgment of you
- Don't feel the group because we aren't always together (as a Church), become
 consumed/influenced by other groups we interact with
- Thinking individually wanting to choose who holds us accountable
- Take for granted God's bigger picture



Now, what changes in your thoughts about being on display if God decides what is to be displayed?

- Caring about how I am affecting the group and how I need to care for others in the group
- Representing God ambassadors what am I saying about God by what I do/say
- Be concerned with knowing what we are to be displaying and removing inaccuracies
- James 3:1 take your role seriously, there are consequences
- Be careful about taking yourself out of "display" when you feel less-than



- We need more churches that understand the meaning of membership






